Business:

- Minutes were approved from the previous District 2 meeting
- NCCCLA has been sending videos from schools about activities that each library has been doing. Videos are sent via MemberPlanet emails. Christine asked members who were not receiving emails to check with her since some schools have firewalls that are blocking the emails.

School reports:

- **James Sprunt:** The library currently has two full-time staff and is hoping to hire a librarian this semester. They have started using Better World Books for discards.
- **Pamlico:** Jane Whitley is the new library director. Moving toward the Learning Commons format. Named to be part of the bond renovation, so they are expecting renovation projects to start soon. Pamlico has a new president and no longer has a Vice President of Instruction. Just adopted an events center, so the library now serves as a booking agency for Pamlico Community College Delamar Center. Pamlico is still suffering with mold problems and lost over 200 books due to mold.
- **Carteret:** Staff has been down one person, so they have been trying to work on getting to a fully staffed status. Carteret closes for one day each year for professional development.
- **Coastal Carolina:** Lots of change in the last year due to transition to the Learning Commons format. Study rooms have been taken due to these changes. A large scale weeding project was done during the summer. Deleted VHS and microfilm collections.

Increased info lit class sessions. Coastal has a new president. Coastal does a monthly/bi-monthly film series.

- **Craven:** Craven has a new president and new administration. Library no longer reports to the Vice President of Instruction. Craven has created a new division called Student Academic Success that the library now reports to.
- **Pitt:** The library is undergoing a complete renovation that is expected to happen in November 2016. They will still be open for full service. They are also undergoing a massive weeding project. Pitt is also constructing a new Science and Technology building.
- **Beaufort:** The library was given \$100,000 to buy furniture for the library. Sandra Pinkham showed pictures of the finished product at the meeting. They eliminated all of their VHS collection.

Training:

- Colleen Turnage did a presentation and answered questions about how to generate various bibliographic and circulation reports from SirsiDynix Workflows.
