



Life Membership Award Guidelines

The Life Membership Award is presented to a person who has retired or is retiring from a learning resource center, library, media center or individual learning center in the community college system of North Carolina or to a person who is in the Library Education profession. The Life Membership Award qualifies a person to be a life member of the NCCCLA. Life members are exempt from paying dues and have all the privileges of active members except that of holding elected office.

Application Guidelines for the Award are:

- Nomination submitted by a member of NCCCLA.
- Nominee has retired/is retiring from the NC Community College System or from the Library Education profession.
- Nominee was an active member of NCCCLA during his/her career.
- Email or Mail the documents to the Awards Chairperson by Friday, February 1st.

A Life Membership Award certificate is presented at the NCCCLA annual conference.
