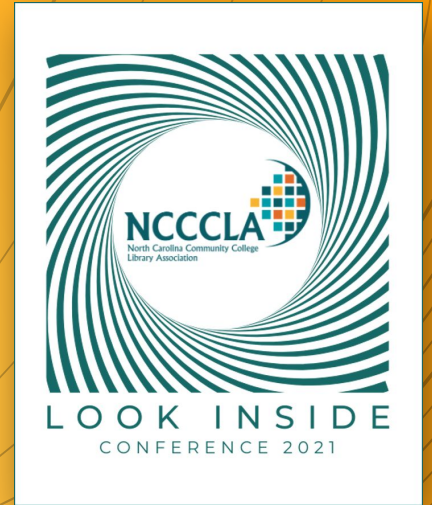

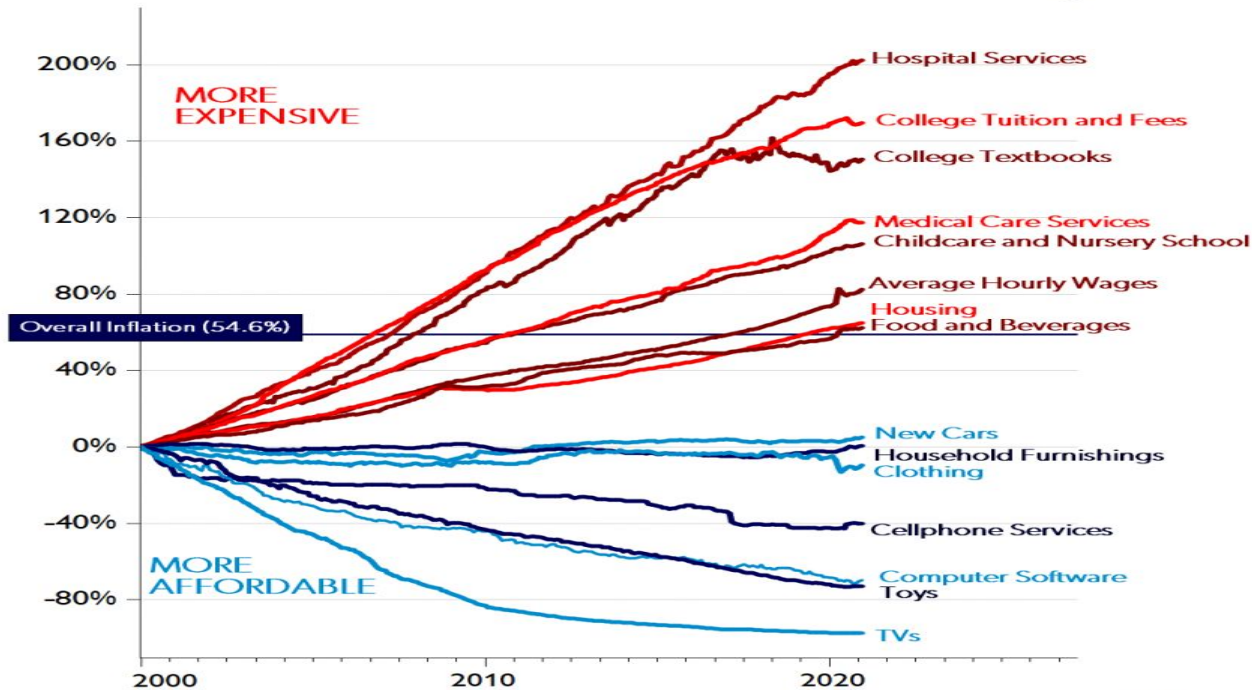

FIXING THE BROKEN TEXTBOOK MARKET

- ❖ 65 percent of students surveyed reported skipping buying a textbook because of cost
- ❖ Students who reported not buying an access code increased from 17 percent in 2019 to 21 percent in 2020
- ❖ 79 percent of students reported being impacted in some way by the pandemic
- ❖ 10 percent of students reported not having reliable enough internet access to participate in remote classes
- ❖ 82 percent of students who reported missing a meal due to the pandemic also reported skipping buying textbooks due to cost

Formed in 2018 from conversations between like-minded librarians, faculty, and staff

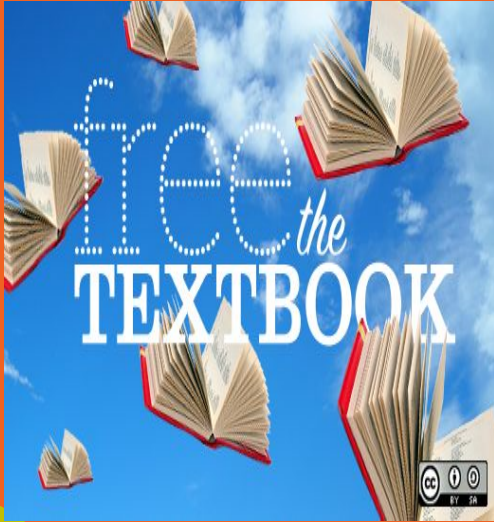
Presentations to stakeholders

ENG instructors put together a crowdsourced list of the top 20 most-wanted content items they wanted in an OER textbook using Google Sheets

Suggested Titles

We sent back an annotated list with links of possibilities for textbooks, full courses, and other resources; committee is currently reviewing

Challenges

Faculty Buy-In

- ◎ Textbook selection process
- ◎ Time to learn OER
- ◎ Growing from a small cohort



Administration Buy-In

- ◎ Requires support from College administration
- ◎ Push for funding
- ◎ Making it an institutional priority
